





Average actual water use among our customers has exceeded estimated uses, putting the District near the limits of its decreed water rights. As you know, Colorado is a semi-arid state, and water is both a precious and a scarce resource. We ask that you use your best efforts to decrease your total water usage by developing conservation measures that will assist in reducing the overall water usage in the District while saving you money on your water bill.

Conserve water – good for the environment – good for your wallet.

Compare your water use with the table below to see if you are within your allowable water use.

Tips to Help Conserve Water:

- Educate employees, contractors and other users in your facility about the importance of water conservation.
- Perform a leak survey or water audit on your facility. Watch the meter after hours or on weekends to see if there is constant flow, which could indicate a leak.
- Replace older toilets and urinals with high-efficiency toilets and urinals.
- Regularly inspect, maintain and repair your boiler systems. Install a condensate return line on your boiler if it does not already have one.
